

# WORKING WITH RAINBOW WORDS

Below you will find a list of different activities for practicing and working with our rainbow words.

- ☆ Write the words on a mirror using a dry erase marker
- ☆ Use a different color marker to write each word or write each letter in each word
- ☆ Use finger to trace words in shaving cream on a cookie sheet or the counter
- ☆ Type the words
- ☆ Write in, on, and all around a cardboard box, Michelangelo style
- ☆ Build the words using play dough
- ☆ Make a puzzle by writing a word on a notecard or sheet of paper and cut into strips. Scramble the pieces and put in the correct order to spell the word
- ☆ Word hunt- write the words on notecards and hide around the house for your child to find
- ☆ Build the words with Legos
- ☆ Use magnetic letters to build the words on the fridge
- ☆ Trace the letters in play dough using a toothpick
- ☆ Paint the words
- ☆ Write words in bubble letters for your child to color in
- ☆ Write the words with glue, sprinkle with glitter, and let dry for fancy rainbow words
- ☆ Find and highlight rainbow words in a magazine or newspaper
- ☆ Make a rainbow word collage by finding the words in magazines and newspapers, cut out, and glue onto a piece of paper
- ☆ Dot paint the words with q-tips
- ☆ String the words with alphabet beads
- ☆ Stamp the
